## Medallion To Be Offered

A limited edition of registered numbered sterling silver medallions commemorating the American Revolution are being made available for purchase, according to the Andover Medallion Committee.

The medallion, designed by the committee members; Mrs. Edward Saulnier, chairman; Col. Edward Harris; Town Clerk Elden R. Salter; and John Lewis Phillips, Sr. and Samuel Phillips, Jr. (father and son) - legislators, educators and benefactors of Andover during the Revolutionary Period. Andover's Bicentennial Logo and a cannon symbolizing Andover's gunpowder mill, so important to the American cause in 1776 and later, will also grace the design.

Number One of the silver medallion will be donated to the Town of Andover for its archives. Orders for registered number silver medallions will be assigned as orders are received. Order forms will soon be available at

key locations in Andover and also by mail.

Orders for the medallions are to be placed on the form with Col. E.M. Harris, USA-Ret., 311 South Main St., Andover, Mass. 01810. Payment should accompany order form.

Medallions should be available by late fall. A bronze unregistered edition will also be available. It is estimated that the cost of the sterling silver medallion will be under twenty dollars and that of the bronze medallion under five dollars.

Although this medallion is being struck by the present Town of

Andover as part of its Bicentennial celebration, it will be recalled that at the time of the American Revolution the town embraced North Andover and that part of Lawrence south of the Merrimack River.
